CBSE Results March 2023:

Class X: The total number of students who appeared were 68 of which 05 passed with 90% and above, 17 above 80%, and 53 above 60%. The school gained cent percent results for class X.

Class XII: The total number of students who appeared were 120 of which 04 passed with 90% and above, 16 above 80%, and 95 above 60%. The school scored 90% results for Class XII.
