Language Development -

- Role Play: Pretend to play a phone call with your little one. This will enhance your child's speaking skills and help him/her understand basic phone etiquette.
- While having meals with your child, talk about the importance and hard work of the farmers and ask him/her not to waste food.





Self-Management Skills

- Help your child to pot few plants and let him/her water the plants and take responsibility of them.
- Make your child the captain of his/her toy store. This will develop a sense of responsibility towards toys in your little one.

Social Skills Development



- Greeting with a smile when someone comes to the house.
 - Visit the local fruit or vegetable market with your child and make your child use magic words please, thank you, sorry, excuse me in their regular conversation with everyone.
 - While sitting at the dining table with the family to eat the meals, try to inculcate proper table manners.
 - Refrain watching television or using mobile phone while having meals with the family.





MAKE YOUR HOME A PLACE FOR READING

- Choose a reading time for your child, as in before a nap, bedtime, or after dinner.
- Don't just read the story; talk about it.
- Let your child point out the letters, shapes, colours and animals.



LEARN TO SPELL YOUR NAME

- 4) Run and Chase










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
Short and Tall

Directions: Color the picture that is short.








