As the New Year has arrived, we are seeing students hoping to do better and better this year. We give our best wishes to them.

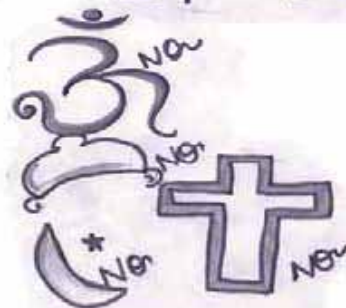

MY DOG DOES MY HOMEWORK

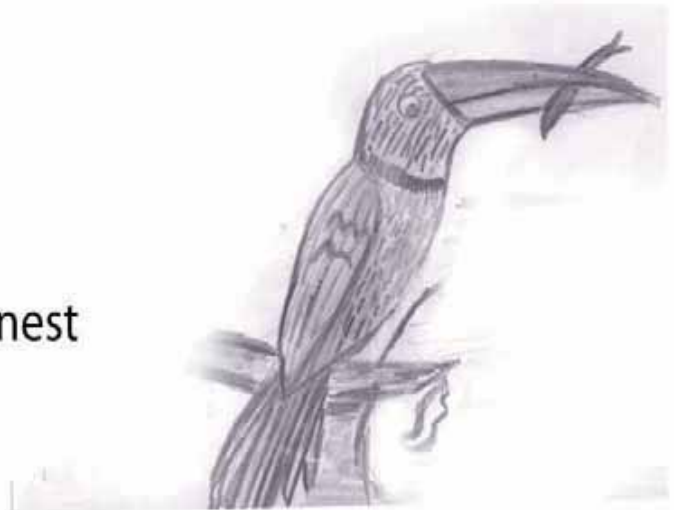
My dog does my homework,

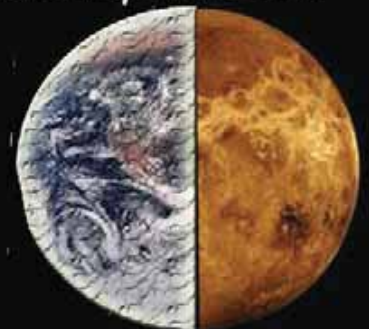

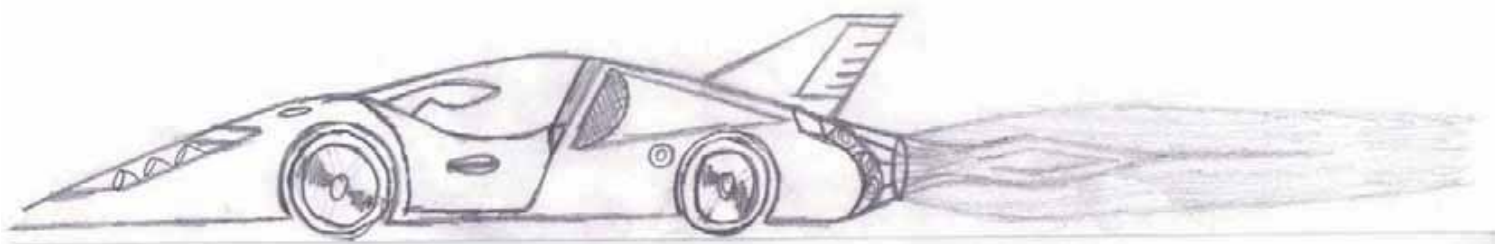

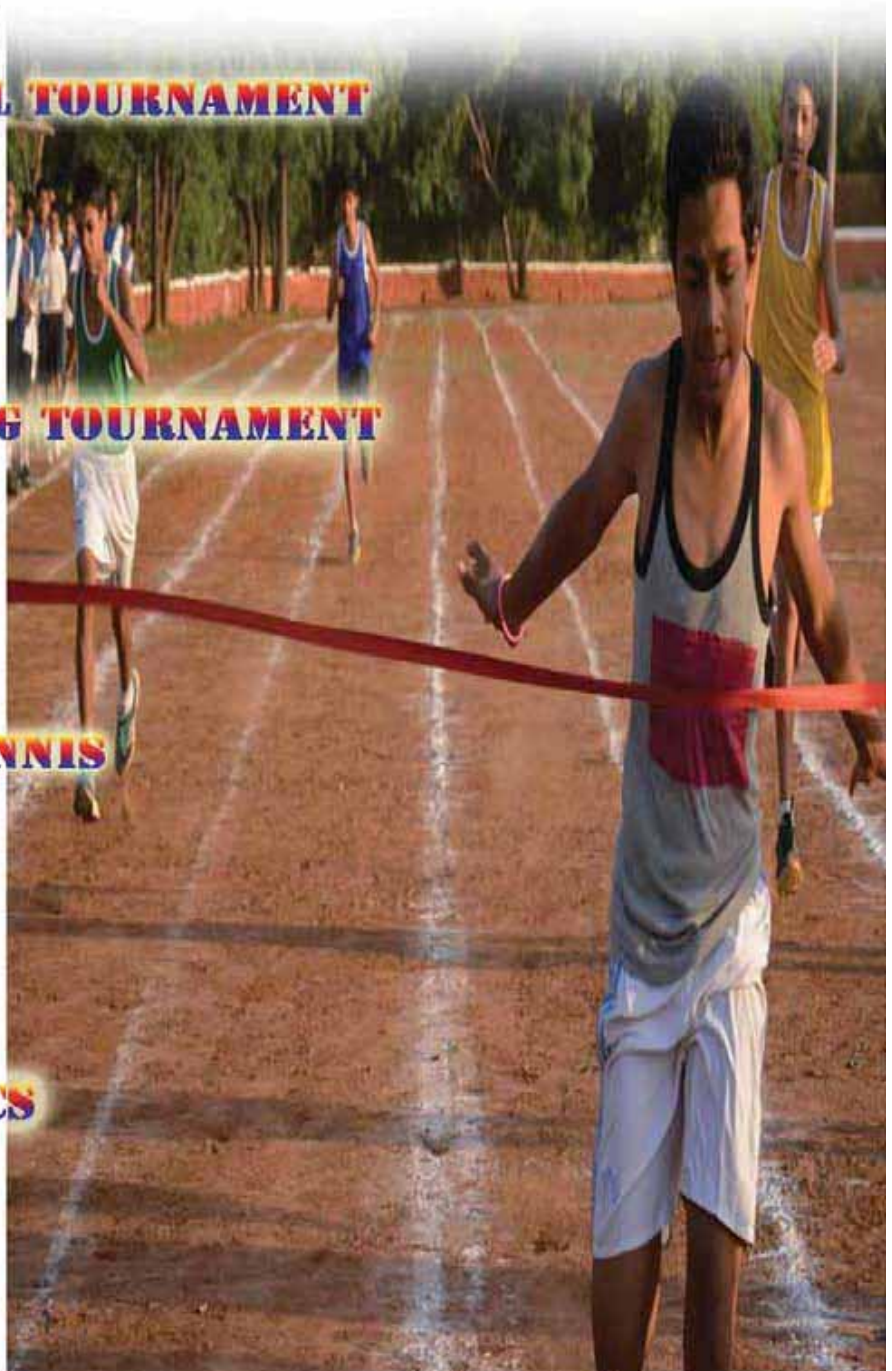
