November 2019, from 6 pm to 8 pm in the Assembly Hall. It was conducted by the Quizmaster, Mr Murli Pillai. The Winners' trophies went to Madhav House and Dattaji House, respectively.

16 students attended a zoom interactive session (video conferencing) as a part of Project PyaR (Python and Research) with University of California. The session was conducted by Mr Raja Guha Thakurta, Chair and Professor, Astronomer, Department of Astronomy and Astrophysics, University of California, Santa Cruz on 2nd December 2019 from 9 am to 10 am in MCR-2.

The students of class XII went for a field visit to the villages - 'Sonsa' and 'Nathon ka Pura' on 2nd December 2019. The purpose of the visit was to collect data, conduct interviews and surveys as a part of their academic curriculum in Geography.

The Social Service League of The Scindia School took an initiative to organize a Tree Plantation Campaign in the school on 29th November 2019. The plantation was done on the barren field behind the Biology Lab. The plan was to do multi-cropping on the fields and develop a kitchen garden. The work started with a demonstration by one of the teachers as to how to plough and develop the sections for crops. We used hand spades to create intercropping area on one

side while we ploughed and dug through the other side to loosen up the soil and to help us with the planting of the seed. With continuous guidance from the teachers and strenuous efforts put in by the students, the League was able to develop the base for a kitchen garden. After that the boys started sowing seeds in the developed sections. We sowed seeds ranging from coriander to radish and onion seeds to potato buds. After that, water was sprinkled on the fields and the kitchen garden was ready. It gave us a supreme sense of gratitude to the wealth of nature bestowed on us.

The School observed the 'Harmony Week' during the last week of November 2019 with various programmes. On 28th November, the observation of



Harmony Week began with the song composed by Sahir Ludhianvi- '*Saathi haath bhadana*' sung by a group of students under the guidance of Ms Ahilya Shinde, in the Morning Assembly. At 7 pm, a talk on the topic, 'Recent Political and Legal Development in India and its Impact on Communal Harmony' was conducted in the Assembly Hall, chaired by an eminent Old Boy, Former Chief Secretary of Jammu and Kashmir and Former Vice Chancellor of Central University of Jammu and Kashmir, Dr Sudhir Bleoria (Ex-Mj, 1962). A Report - Cyber Scindia Inter House IT Week-2019

Cyber Scindia Inter House IT Week 2019-20 was conducted in The Scindia School from 18th November to 23rd November 2019. Following events were conducted with great enthusiasm and eagerness for Senior group & Junior group:

1. IT quiz was conducted on 18th November in Lab-1 and Lab-2 for both Sr. and Jr. houses. The focus was to evaluate the technical knowledge of the students, and they all participated positively by creating a true spirit of Quizzing. Keshav

Jhunjhunwala of Dattaji house performed remarkably well by answering most of the questions which the Sr. students were not able to answer.

2. Digital Poster Making & Multimedia Presentation was conducted on 19th November. For Sr. houses "School Poster" and "Biochip" were given as the topics respectively, and for Jr. houses, they competed on "My Home in Space" and "World 2030" respectively. Most of the students were in their imagination about the world after a decade, and they did it wonderfully well. Devansh Agarwal presented well with custom animations rather than using the existing animations on the software.

3. Video Editing was conducted for Senior Houses on the topic "Live Mindfully"

and “Website Designing” was conducted for both Sr. and Jr. houses on the topics “Cyber Terrorism” and “Fitness for All” on 21st November.

For Video Editing, the students used Adobe Premier Pro software and created a 5 minutes short video from the raw footages given with lots of visual effects. One of the students recorded his sound and created a voice-over for his edited video, and it was truly out-of-the-box thinking while the other one was using rewind effect. Website designing event was extremely outstanding, in which two of our students were able to develop a factual website for Cyber Terrorism with the help of Adobe Dream viewer software with CSS and enhanced the visual impact by incorporating Parallax effect on their webpage and thus by creating a professional touch.

4. Photo Editing on the topic “True Your Dreams” was conducted for Sr., and Jr. houses and Sound Editing for Sr. houses were conducted on 22nd November. Photo Editing was done mostly using Adobe Photoshop 2017 and students displayed their creativity in a good manner. Shayn Rohra of Nimaji house practiced a lot for the photo editing event and showed his passion for editing photos.

For sound editing, some students used minute sound detailing of robot genesis, and it was mind-blowing and up to the mark.

5. Cartoon Making on the topic “Happiness” and Computer Whiz Kid was conducted on 23rd November for Sr. houses.

The cartoon making event was quite interesting which exposed the artist within the students because they all tried to narrate what is Happiness within the limited time and they could relate happiness with money, fame etc., while the ultimate Happiness is a state of mind. Abhey Khanna of Jayaji house was pleasingly sketching the cartoon using Adobe Photoshop, and he will go a long way.

The senior students got a chance to showcase their programming skills through Whiz Kid event. They were given a problem to accept a string from the user and find whether it is a Lapindrome or not, within the minimum time and number of lines of codes. (Lapindrome is defined as a string which, when split in the middle, gives two halves having the same characters and same frequency of each character. If there are an odd number of characters in the string, we ignore the middle character and check for lapindrome. For example, gaga is a lapindrome, since the two halves ga and ga have the same characters with the same frequency. Also, abccab, rotor and xyzxy are a few examples of lapindromes. Note that abbaab is NOT a lapindrome. The two halves contain the same character, but their frequencies do not match. Your task is simple. Given a string, you need to tell if it is a Lapindrome).
